




CHECK YOUR LINES AND HARDWARE REGULARLY



THE RING WHICH RIDES UP AND DOWN SPENDS MORE TIME AT THE LOWEST POINT AND CAN WEAR A NOTCH IN THE TRAVELER PIPE. WHEN THE TIDE RISES IT CAN SINK A BOAT BY KEEPING THE RING FROM RISING

TURNING IT AROUND




IF BOTH SIDES ARE WORN


IT CAN BE SALVAGED BY


TURNING IT UPSIDE DOWN


IF THE BOTTOM END IS

NOT ROTTED OUT










THE HOLE IN THE PILING
