## THINGS A FRIEND OF THE RIVER AT THE YYC NEEDS TO KNOW

	Annual Dues for Friend of the River are \$499.50 plus sales tax. Dues are per year, not matter when you join.
	Friends of the River shall have access to the clubhouse and picnic areas only.
	No swimming is allowed in the basin or river at any time.
	Friends of the River privileges can be revoked at any time at the discretion of the Yonkers Yacht Club Board.
	Friends of the River pay a refundable \$25.00 key deposit.
	Prospective Friends of the River will pay the \$25 cost for a credit check.
	Friends of the River and any guests (up to a maximum of four) are required to log in when
	they come to the club, and log out when they leave. Guest Book is located at the front door of the club.
	No minors are allowed unless they are accompanied and supervised by a Friend of the River at all times. Any minor under 12 years of age is required to wear a Coast-Guard Approved PFD at all times while on club property.
	Friends of the River are provided with an ID Card signed by an officer of the Yonkers Yacht Club. Friends of the River must display their ID card upon request.
	Friends of the River can bring no more than four friends down on any given day. There are no exceptions to this rule. If this rule is abused, or if the same friends come down constantly to the club without becoming a Friend of the River themselves, the Yonkers Yacht Club reserves the right to revoke Friend of the River status at any time. We want to be generous and welcoming, but we don't want people to take advantage of us.
	The Yonkers Yacht Club has the right to revoke Friends of the River status at any time.
	No Parking on the path that leads from Warburton Avenue down to the footbridge. You must unload your vehicle then park on Warburton Ave.
	No Dogs permitted in the Club House.

## Description of Friends of the River from the Constitution and By-Laws of the Yonkers Yacht Club

Friends of the River have no ownership stake in the club. They are not members. They will not be obligated to perform any work hours. They are required to abide by all Yonkers Yacht Club By-Laws, Rules, and Regulations. Friends of the River shall have access to the clubhouse and picnic areas only. No swimming is allowed in the basin or river at any time. Friends of the River shall pay \$499.50 plus sales tax per year. Friends of the River privileges can be revoked at any time at the discretion of the Yonkers Yacht Club Board. They will pay a refundable \$25 key deposit. They and any guests (up to a maximum of 4) will be required to log in when they come to the club, and log out when they leave. No minors are allowed unless they are accompanied and supervised by a Friend of the River at all times. Any minor under 12 years of age is required to wear a Coast-Guard Approved PFD at all times while on club property.

**Friends of the River Kayaker** is designed for people who have kayaks. Friends of the River Kayaker shall have all privileges and obligations described above in Friends of the River. Friends of the River Kayaker shall pay \$599.50 plus sales tax per year for their kayak. Any and all Coast Guard and New York State Regulations must be followed at all times.
